



## Enhanced Vaccine Certificate Requirements

### Point Edward Memorial Arena

With the recent release of the provincial enhanced vaccine certificate and Lambton Public Health letter of direction, the entry requirements for the Point Edward Memorial Arena will be changing to help ensure the safety of our facility users.

Starting **Monday, November 1, 2021** an enhanced vaccine certificate QR code **MUST** be presented to the screening staff at the door when attempting to enter the facility. Printed or photocopied vaccine receipts without a QR code will **no longer** be accepted. Identification must also be presented.

#### Acceptable Proof of Vaccination

- ✓ Province of Ontario enhanced vaccination certificate saved on a handheld device, such as a phone or tablet. A photo of the QR code, copy of a PDF or file containing the QR code or the code saved in a wallet or health app are acceptable.
- ✓ A printed copy of the individuals Province of Ontario enhanced vaccination certificate QR code
- ✓ Regardless of the method of presenting the QR code, the code must be of high enough quality to be readable and verifiable by the **Verify Ontario** app. QR codes that will not scan **will not** be accepted and entry will be denied.
- ✓ Medical exemptions are still valid and must meet the provincial criteria. Please see the link below for more information.

#### What is NOT Acceptable Proof of Vaccination

- ✗ A printed receipt from an individuals first or second dose vaccination, whether obtained during their appointment or through the provincial website, that does not contain the individuals enhanced QR code.

#### Acceptable Proof of Identification

- ✓ Proof of identity showing name of the identification holder AND date of birth. Examples include:
  - Birth certificate
  - Citizenship card
  - Driver's License
  - Health card
  - Indian status card
  - Passport

**NOTE:** Proof of vaccination and ID is required for ANYONE entering the facility that is 12 years old and older.
