- 1. Minutes from previous meeting approved. Motion passed by Lynz & Seconded by Moe. All in favour.

- 2. Financial Report: Lynz
 - Sting assist cheque has been deposited. We are very grateful to be a recipient this year
 - Insurance for OMHA has increased substantially this year.
 - o Lottery accounts are in good standing with reports filed
 - Banking balances shared
 - Hockey Registration payment deadline for the upcoming season is September 5th.

Updates and Outstanding Items:

3. Soccer was challenging to coordinate this year with so few board members & volunteers .

- Next season, we would like to establish a soccer committee and appoint a liaison for the board to help improve the program.
- Photo retakes there are 2 players photos left to be picked up.
- Discussed the possibility of a new "year end" wrap up tradition might be a good solution as well. Instead of pizza maybe ice cream sandwiches or a different snack. Something the coaches can hand out after the game. This would eliminate the need for so many volunteers for the last week of soccer, less clean up, and easier on our volunteers. It was a struggle this year reminding families that the pizza and drinks was just for the coaches and players, not siblings and other family members.
- 4. Hockey:
 - U7 The U7 minor & major teams were combined this year and then evenly split into 2 separate teams Red & White. A meeting was held with last years coaches as well as with this years coaches and junior convenors to divide up the players. We want to thank everyone involved in dividing the teams as well as the parents for being patient and understanding.
 - U7 game schedule is in the works for this season.
 - We have seen an increased drop out rate for our U7 teams. There have been 4 players so far. 3 prior to combining the teams.
 - U9 Tiering will happen for the second half of the season. Each center is to submit their tiering level by mid December to LMLL.
 - For the first half of the season U9 teams will play more local to them teams. Then once full ice the teams will play centers in their tier.
 - Equipment pre-paid sock order forms have gone out the coaches and managers. This year U7 U18 players will receive 1 home & 1 away pair of performance socks.
 - We will be adding to the code of conduct prior to the start of the season that team coloured socks are to be worn during games. We will work on the wording to ensure to note that if there is an alternative plan or occasion i.e green for Face Off for Mental Health, prior approval from the board for game attire will be required.
 - The replacement red jerseys for the players that have aged out are ready to be picked up at Team Outfitters.
 - Shooter Tutor samples from Forge Hockey will be available for us to try. We would like to buy one to be used at practices.
 - \circ New practice pucks have been ordered & delivered. Moe to drop them off to lock up.
 - Game pucks have been ordered.
