- 1. Meeting Minutes from Previous Meeting Pending

- 2. Financial Report Lynz & Liz
 - Balances for operating and lottery accounts shared
 - November ice bill has been paid
- 3. Teams
 - All team player rosters are submitted/approved as well as our volunteer rosters.
 - o AP players have been submitted and approved, deadline for AP was Jan 15th
 - Up coming tournaments U9 & U11 Niagara (separate tournaments), U13 Windsor, U15-18 Buffalo. We wish our teams all good luck and hope they have fun!
- 4. Soccer -Liz
 - We need to determine if we will be using the same fee structure as last year.
 - We need to open registration up in the next few weeks to align with other organizations.
 - Review registration numbers and review older division game structure. Possibly 1 revert to "pick up game style" and use pinnies??? (we didn't have enough players for 4 full teams last year. More discussion to be had TBD
 - Soccer committee we have received folks indicating they would sit on a committee.
 Jarod would chair the committee as part of his learning experience.

- 5. Welcome Jarod!
 - Jarod will be supporting us with soccer, U7 jamboree, etc.
 - He is currently enrolled in the Lambton College Sports & Rec program.
 - We look forward to working with Jarod and his enthusiasm he will bring to the group.
- 6. Forge Hockey Liz
 - We have a trial shooter tutor currently that the teams have been trying out. The feedback has been good.
 - Moe is going to reach out to the owner of Forge. He has a few more questions on pricing around how the logo is applied, and finishes available
 - Teams seem to like the netting for the glove and coaches like how it folds in half and can be easily carried and stored.

 - Team tiering for divisions after first half of the season seeding is not as well received as hoped by all teams.
